Political Developments

Silk Route to KKH and CPEC

Historically, parts of Gilgit-Baltistan especially Gilgit and Hunza were extremely important transit points in the Silk Route that spread from Europe to China which at that point was the most important trade route in the world. In modern history of Pakistan, this silk route was replaced by the Karakoram Highway which was built with great labour and sacrifice by both Pakistan and China. The KKH construction has increased the status of GB which has gained all the more strategic importance as China's presence next door and an unobstructed connection between China and Pakistan which will soon extend to other parts of the world as well. The US interests of containing Chinese influence converge with those of India. And with this convergence, comes the threat of attempts to destabilise CPEC projects both from India and the US

Earlier, India was also involved in terrorist attacks on the Pearl Continental Hotel in Gwadar and the Chinese consulate in Karachi. India is beyond any doubt, directly involved in terrorism—especially in Balochistan. Pakistan has already exposed India's nefarious design against CPEC. DG ISPR last year exposed India's links, financing, training and sponsorship of terrorism to the world. Pakistan's security forces will continue to thwart all hostile attempts to sabotage the project and destabilise the country.

Protest in AJK against Israeli attacks on Al-Aqsa Mosque

People in Azad Jammu and Kashmir took out a rally in protest against the Israeli aggression at the *Al-Aqsa* mosque and in solidarity with the Palestinian people. A significant number of people marched from the Shaheed Burhan Wani Chowk towards the main city and chanted slogans against Israeli atrocities in Palestine. Sloganeering against Indian atrocities in IOK was also heard. The protest was organised by Pasbaan-e-Hurriyat with support from many local political and religious personalities.

The protestors held banners showing solidarity with the people of Palestine and demanding the establishment of an independent Palestine. They called on the International organisations especially the UN to intervene in the volatile situation. They also reiterated that the OIC should formulate a solid and comprehensive strategy to counter Israeli terrorism. Speaking on the occasion, Chairman Pasban-e-Hurriyat Uzair Ahmad Ghazali said the Israeli attack on Al-Aqsa Mosque and Muslims is the open testimony about usurpation of religious rights.

"People of Kashmir stands shoulder to shoulder with their Palestinian brethren," adding that the United Nations must take stern notice Israeli attacks on innocent Palestinians.

GB Govt Issues Guidelines for Eid-ul-Fitr Celebration in order to minimize the risk

Gilgit-Baltistan government issued guidelines for Eid celebrations in accordance with the instructions of the National Command Operation Centre (NCOC) which is the nerve centre to synergize and articulate unified national effort against COVID-19. As per this notification, worshippers were ordered to organise Eid prayers in open space under stringent covid-19 protocols. If because of any reasons prayer is organized inside the Mosque, all doors and windows needs to be kept open to minimize chances of spread of the virus in the closed space.

The *Ulemas* were asked to keep the Eid sermon short so that people only gather for a short period of time. Thermal screening was made mandatory at the entry points of all places of worship. People were also asked to perform the ablutions at home and come to the Eidgah with their own prayer mats. Banners highlighting Covid management protocols were also to be displayed at prominent places at the prayer venue.

Reversal of IIOJK status should be precondition for talks with India: Masood

Azad Jammu Kashmir President Sardar Masood Khan has cautioned the Pakistan authorities from getting involved in a bilateral dialogue with India without India reversing its decision of revoking the special status of the 'Occupied Territory'. The President said that a bilateral dialogue without these pre-conditions will endorse India's 'fascist agenda' in Kashmir and the various war crimes which include demographic change, land grabbing, detentions, killings and cultural invasion.

While not undermining the importance of the ceasefire agreement in saving and improving lives of the people living on both sides of the LoC, the President still insisted that the Pakistan should be cautious while going down that road with India without being fully aware of India's intentions.

Lifting of the protracted and brutal military siege of Kashmir, restoration of the pre-August 5, 2019 status of the occupied territory and revocation of all illegal domicile certificates issued to more than three million non-natives are some of the minimum confidence-building measures required before any engagement with India, he said. The President went on to say that the Kashmir issue had been successfully internationalized in the past few years and any concession

from the Pakistani side would release that pressure on India and losing the international space that Kashmir had so acquired.

Rs 50 Billion Shandur-Gilgit road included in GB development package

The federal government of Pakistan has decided to include the 216-kilometre Shandur-Gilgit road into the recently announced Rs 370 billion upliftment package for GB. The 50 billion rupees investment project which will provide an alternate route to the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) would be completed under the umbrella of the Integrated GB Development Plan 2021-26. The new road would be an all-weather road, providing an alternative route to CPEC during the winter when the Silk Route is closed due to snowfall. After Lowari Tunnel, the project will be another top notch and time saving route for travelling to the region.

The total length of the road is 363 km, of which 216 km are within GB territory. The project PC-1 has been submitted to the Planning Commission for subsequent approval from Central

Development Working Party (CDWP) and Executive Committee of National Economic Council (ECNEC).

First CPEC hydropower project on Jhelum reaches closer to completion

Lieutenant General (retd) Asim Saleem Bajwa, Chairman of the China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) Authority announced on Wednesday that 88% work on 720 megawatt Karot Hydropower Project has been completed. The Chairman claimed that the project had created 5,000 jobs for the local residents. The project that spans over Punjab and AJK on the river Jhelum is expected to be completed in the year 2022 with total estimated investment of \$ 1720 million.

This news comes only a month after the GB government signed an agreement with the Three Gorges Company of China to implement 1124 MW Kohala Hydel Project under CPEC. The 2.4 billion dollar project in Kohala will be the Chinese company's largest investment in Pakistan. In his tweet, General Asim used the hash tag, 'CPEC making progress' which clearly shows he is trying to clear any doubts regarding the slowing down of CPEC projects.

No talks with India until Aug 2019 steps undone: PM Imran

Prime Minister Imran Khan has said that Islamabad will not resume talks with New Delhi until it restores the special status of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

"Unless India reverts its August 5, 2019 action, Pakistan will not hold talks," Premier Imran said while responding to a caller on 'Apka Wazir-e-Azam Apke Sath' programme during which he took telephone calls from citizens. We will not talk to India until they withdraw their unilateral August 5 move. Western countries are preparing India against China as an opponent on the global economic front. That is why these countries are silent on atrocities in Occupied Kashmir. PM Imran's comments during the programme came days after Saudi Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan Al Saud said that Saudi Arabia will work to encourage reduction in tension between Pakistan and India.

In the same programme, the PM also answered important questions regarding the sugar mafia, rebuilding of the economy, curbing corruption and inflation, border security, Covid-19 situation and expat portal.

LoC, Ceasefire agreement and the Kashmiri people

The agreement to implement the 2003 ceasefire agreement was signed on February 25, 2021 between India and Pakistan. Pakistan, as usual, once again decided to give peace a chance. This agreement was highly appreciated by the international community, especially in the Western world and in the United States. It should be remembered that this agreement was signed during the tenure of General Musharraf. India had by then erected an iron fence on the LOC with the cooperation of Israel and as soon as its nefarious objectives were achieved, India adopted its traditional policy of state terrorism in J and K and started violating the ceasefire as per its convenience.

For the past ten years, the Indian Army has fired on the vehicles of UN military observers in Chhamb, Rawalpindi and other sectors, yet the UN has remained silent in the name of lack of evidence. These international military observers are allowed to do their work with full authority in the Pakistan and Azad Jammu and Kashmir region and they are doing so but in occupied Jammu and Kashmir they are confined to their camps. They have been evicted from their official residences in Delhi and many human rights groups have been asked to leave the country but the United Nations has remained suspiciously silent.

The need of the hour now is not just to implement the ceasefire agreement, because India will unilaterally violate it whenever it feels expedient. But for the world powers, institutions and the United Nations to try and implement the resolutions on Kashmir in accordance with more than 18 unanimous resolutions that were passed by the Security Council has become difficult. Pakistan urges the world community to ensure the right of the Kashmiri people to self-determination and implement the report of the Human Rights Commission and punish the Indian occupiers like it did in the case of Yugoslavia.

Unconditional release of political prisoners, repeal of black laws should also be ensured. International measures should be taken to restore all civil, human and political rights of the people of Occupied Jammu and Kashmir and to stop the systematic genocide of Kashmiris so that real and meaningful results of the ceasefire can be achieved.
