Fraud and fury in Kashmir

More 'fraudulent arrangements' are being imposed on 'occupied' Jammu

and Kashmir by Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi's government. Three years after the 'illegal annexation', 'bifurcations', and 'integration' of Jammu and Kashmir into the Indian union, Delhi has continued to 'abuse' the area with deception and force to maintain its 'unlawful' hold over the region. The condition of the Kashmiri people got 'worse' after August 5, 2019, when a new chapter in the 'torturous' history of the 'occupied' area was opened. To avoid a local 'uprising' against the action that effectively 'stripped' the Kashmiri people of all of their rights, a protracted 'brutal' lockdown and communication blackout were implemented, the 'military siege' was tightened, the press was restrained, and Kashmiri leaders were imprisoned.

International human rights organizations claimed 'rampant torture' and 'arbitrary arrests', with people being taken from their homes and kids being 'shot' with pellet guns to 'make them blind'. The most recent report from India's Forum of Human Rights in J&K revealed that 'violations' of human rights had 'persisted unabatedly.' Since August 2019, the PM Modi's government has consolidated its power on Kashmir and has taken 'repressive' moves to prepare for potential elections that would 'legitimize' its 'unlawful activities.' These initiatives have included using 'electoral fraud' as a model to 'weaken' Muslims in the 'occupied' territories. Recently, another attempt to alter the demographics of the area was made with the proclamation by the top electoral official in the 'occupied' valley

that any Indian citizen, even one who is only temporarily residing there, will be allowed to vote. This is a 'brazen violation' of UN Security Council resolutions on Kashmir as was the August 2019 action. There are 11 UN resolutions on Kashmir. Specifically, the move contravenes UNSC resolution 38, whose para 2 clearly states that neither party to the dispute can bring about a 'material change' in the situation in Kashmir.

Internal dissent surfaces in the 'Azad Kashmir' government

A major member of the ruling Pakistan Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI) party in 'Azad Jammu and Kashmir' (AJK) launched a clandestine effort to oust Prime Minister Sardar Tanveer Ilyas on his own, but it appears to have failed so far due to a lack of support from the parliamentary party. Ilyas was elected as the new Leader of the House in April this year, replacing Sardar Abdul Qayyum Niazi, the first pick of Imran Khan, after the PTI clinched a clear victory in July 2021 polls in 'Azad Kashmir.' The 'AJK' capital, however, has recently once more been the subject of rumors that another motion of no confidence is imminent, after Speaker Chaudhry Anwarul Haq's tense interactions with Mr. Ilyas and his claimed covert meetings with some opposition figures to solicit their support for his candidacy for the coveted job. Ilyas' nomination for the AJK premiership was initially strongly

supported by Mr. Haq, but the two have been at odds for the past few months over what he perceives to be the latter's 'extraordinary leanings' toward the president of 'AJK' Sultan Mahmood. According to sources in the PTI, he was particularly enraged by Mahmood being given preference in matters about the Mirpur division, particularly the postings and removals of senior officials. Mr. Mahmood and Mr. Haq are both from the Mirpur division, specifically the Bhimber and Mirpur districts. Ilyas had discussed in detail the prevailing situation with Aamer Mehmood Kiani, PTI's additional secretary general, in the context of the origin of rumors about a no trust against him, and both had resolved to cut the 'conspirators' down to size.

Geelani's legacy continues to dominate politics in 'held Kashmir:' APHC leader

While paying tributes to 'pro-freedom' Kashmiri leader Syed Ali Shah Geelani on his first death anniversary, Altaf Hussain Wani, a leader of the All Parties Hurriyat Conference (APHC) said that his legacy continued to dominate political life in the 'occupied' region, and added that Geelani was a towering personality and an internationally recognized leader who spent all his life advocating the Kashmiris' 'legitimate right-the right to self-determination.' He further said that the deceased leader was an

ideologue and a strong proponent of Kashmiris' rights and that his lifelong struggle and sacrifices for the Kashmir cause will serve as a 'beacon light' for coming generations, who believe in the principle of justice, freedom and human rights. While reiterating Kashmiris' pledge to take the 'ongoing movement' to its logical end, he said that the best way to pay the tribute to Geelani was to 'uphold' his 'mission' and follow the proud legacy he had left behind, added that India must take a leaf out of Kashmir's history and know that it cannot 'suppress' their 'legitimate political struggle' by the dint of force or putting them in jails.

Ali Gilani's thoughts are still a ray of hope for Kashmiri youth

History demonstrates that those who influenced human thought, lived and were dedicated to a cause, and made the ultimate sacrifice for freedom did not pass away; this is also true of Syed Ali Geelani, who did not pass away but merely disappeared physically. His words will continue to inspire young people in Kashmir. On September 1, 2021, Syed Ali Gilani accepted 'martyrdom' while being held by Indian authorities at his home in Hyderpora, Srinagar. Indian authorities held him under continuous 'illegal' house arrest for more than ten years, but they were unable to 'snatch' the idea of 'independence' and

'resistance' from him. Geelani was stronger than more than a million members of the Indian 'occupied forces', so even after his death, he continued to represent fear for them. Indian forces had forcibly removed Geelani's body for burial at the Hyderpora cemetery during a night-time 'military siege', against the veteran leader's last wishes.

Geelani was a strong voice of Pakistan in 'IoK:' President of 'AJK'

The president of 'Azad Jammu and Kashmir', Sultan Mahmood Chaudhry has said that Syed Ali Geelani was the strong voice of Pakistan in 'occupied' Kashmir who raised the slogan 'Hum Pakistani Hain, Pakistan Hamara hay.' Kashmiri diaspora asks 'AJK' government to declare Sept 1 'Youm-e-Baba-e-Hurriyat' day

The Kashmiri diaspora has called upon the 'Azad Jammu and Kashmir' (AJK) government to declare September 1 as 'Youm-e-Baba-e-Hurriyat' or 'Day of Father of Freedom Movement' to honor the 'sacrifices' of Hurriyat leader Syed Ali Geelani. In a letter addressed to 'AJK' Prime Minister Sardar Tanvir Ilyas Khan, Kashmiri diaspora leader Fahim Kayani said the commemoration of the first martyrdom anniversary of 'Shaheed' Geelani on September 1 is a step toward recalling his relentless efforts to free 'IIOJK' from India's 'illegal military occupation.' He also suggested that the 'AJK'

government should announce a policy framework to study the services of Shaheed Geelani so that it is included in 'resistance literature' for future generations.

Kohala Hydropower Project creates vast employment opportunities for people: Raja Farrukh Khursheed

Inquiry into the Neelum-Jhelum project's 'failure' begins

The Ministry of Water Resources in collaboration with the Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA) will conduct an inquiry into the 'failure' of the 969 megawatts Neelum-Jhelum hydropower project and hire international 'experts' for the investigation process. The Ministry of Water Resources and WAPDA has started the investigation process and the former has sought expressions of interest from international research companies. The sources said that the investigation would determine whether it was a bad 'design' or 'substandard construction' behind the 'failure' and after the investigation by international experts, the ministry will determine the officials responsible for the project's 'failure.' The Ministry of Water Resources said that WAPDA had been entrusted with investigating the damage caused to the Mohmand dam by the recent devastating floods. The Neelum-Jhelum hydropower plant was part of a run-of-the-river hydroelectric power scheme in 'Azad Jammu and Kashmir', designed to divert water from the Neelum River to a power station on the Jhelum River. The construction of the project began in 2008 after a Chinese consortium was

awarded the construction contract in July 2007.

This year, 117 distinct instances in 'occupied Kashmir' resulted in the 'unlawful' killing of 147 youths: Hurriyat leader

According to the Hurriyat leader, Abdul Hameed Lone, 147 youngsters were 'extra-judicially executed' in 117 separate incidents in 'occupied' Kashmir this year. He claimed in a statement that three more Kashmiri teenagers had died in a fake encounter in Shopian part of 'occupied Kashmir.' He alleged that young people were killed during the 'fabricated' search operation in the region by the Indian 'occupying forces.' He claimed that 16 Kashmiris were slaughtered in 'fake' encounters in August, making a total of 147 youngsters 'extra-judicially' killed in 117 separate occurrences in 'occupied' Kashmir this year. He claimed that since the threats made by the head of the Indian police, Dilbagh Singh, the number of 'fatalities had steadily grown' and that the Indian 'occupying' forces had been allowed to 'slaughter' Kashmiris. Even Syed Geelani's grave is a source of fear for India: JI Leader

The former National Assembly member and deputy leader of Jamaat-e-Islami (JI) Pakistan, Mian Mohammad Aslam said that India's failure stems from its 'fear' of Syed Ali Shah Geelani's grave, and added that the name Syed Ali Shah Geelani refers to both a movement and a vision. He said that Ali Shah Geelani created history by serving years in an Indian prison and after his death, millions of his 'ideological adherents' will continue his work. 22 crore people are 'supporting' his cause, and that he was a symbol of 'resistance.' He further claimed that Kashmiris do not accept any formula and that they would continue to fight until they achieve 'complete independence', and that it is unacceptable to divide Kashmir. He said that Geelani spent his entire life fighting for Kashmir 'freedom' and the supremacy of the Islamic faith and that India was terrified when Syed Ali Geelani passed away, so instead of giving his body to his family, he was 'forcibly' buried, which is equivalent to openly interfering with Islam.
