Iran Asks IAEA Chief Not to Make Comments for Media Consumption

Spokesman of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) Behrouz Kamalvandi blasted the UN nuclear watchdog's Chief Rafael Grossi for making "unprofessional" remarks for media consumption. "I amicably advise Rafael Grossi, the director-general of the [International Atomic Energy] Agency, to take distance from making unprofessional statements of political hue and color intended for media" consumption, Kamalvandi said on Wednesday. His remarks came after the head of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) called on Iran to resume talks "now" on reviving the 2015 nuclear accord before things get "much more problematic". "It is clear that if there is a technical issue, it should be presented professionally within the framework of the Agency's duties and followed through its own channels and through the usual mechanisms of the Agency. Obviously, the arena for such interactions is not the media," he said.

Iran's Home-Made 'Zoljanah' Satellite Carrier under Launch Tests

Spokesman of the Space Department of the Iranian Defense Ministry Ahmad Hosseini said that the country plans to test its domestically-developed Zoljanah satellite carrier. "Three launches of the Zoljanah satellite carrier were planned for research; one has so far been conducted and two others will be carried out later," Hosseini said on Wednesday. The performance of the three-stage carrier, which uses compound fuel, can be evaluated in each launch, he said. The satellite carrier weighs 52 tons and is 25.5 meters in length. It can carry loads of up to 220 kilograms at an orbit of 500 kilometers above the surface, Hosseini said. Last week, the Iranian Space Agency said work has been underway to prepare seven more satellites for launch into the orbit.

Ex-IRGC Commander: Israel's Assassination Attempts Have No Technical Operational Value

Gen. Jafari was commenting on statements by Israeli officials about some recent incidents in Iran, for which they have tried to imply responsibility.

Iranian Army's F14 Fighter Jet Crashes in Isfahan, Nobody Killed

An F14 fighter jet crashed in Isfahan, Central Iran on Saturday due to a technical failure, but no one was killed as the two pilots ejected before the crash. "The aircraft

faced a technical defect in the engine at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday morning during the mission," Head of Army Public Relations in the Isfahan region announced. "The pilot and co-pilot landed with a parachute and were taken to the hospital for medical treatment due to some injuries during landing," Rasoul Motamedi said. In a similar incident in May, an F-7 fighter of the Iranian Army crashed in Isfahan province, killing two officers on board.

AEOI Spokesman: IAEA Notified of Iran's Natanz Construction Work

Atomic Energy Organization of Iran Spokesman Behrouz Kamalvandi confirmed that Iran had notified the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) of AEOI's plan to relocate the activities of the TESA complex in Karaj to the Natanz facility. The AEOI spokesman's remarks came in response to reports by the western media about construction activities near the Natanz nuclear site. Kamalvandi underlined that the relocation was taken to intensify security measures around Iran's nuclear facilities. "Even though Iran has no obligation to provide such information to the IAEA, the agency had been informed of the same," he added. Referring to last year's sabotage at the TESA complex, the AEOI spokesman said the transfer of some of the activities to an area near the Natanz nuclear site aims to prevent the recurrence of such attacks. The complex in Karaj, on the outskirts of Tehran, saw a sabotage attack in June last year, which Iranian authorities blamed the Israeli regime for it.

The attack damaged surveillance cameras at the site.

The Israel military said in a February statement that Israeli F-15 fighter jets have escorted an American B-52 bomber as it made its way en route to the Persian Gulf. The B-52H Stratofortress, which is capable of carrying a nuclear weapon, flew from its base in the United Kingdom, through the Straits of Gibraltar, over the Mediterranean, and out over the Red Sea, before traveling back on roughly the same route to the UK.

‘Martyr Soleimani’ Helicopter-Carrier Warship to Join IRGC Navy

Commander of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps Navy Rear Admiral Alireza Tangsiri said that a new home-made warship named after Iran’s anti-terror commander martyr Lieutenant General Qassem Soleimani will be delivered to the IRGC Navy Soon. “We now manufacture our own frigates. Shahid (Martyr) Soleimani helicopter carrier is also expected to join the IRGC naval fleet in the near future. We indigenously build various types of high-speed boats that cruise at speeds of 70 to 90 nautical knots,” Rear Admiral Alireza Tangsiri said at a ceremony in Tehran on Monday. Head of the Marine Industries Organization of Iran Rear Admiral Amir Rastegari announced in April 2020 that the country will build a 6,000-ton destroyer, and said it has the ability to produce nuclear-powered

submarines. “The destroyer will be a trimaran ship – a vessel consisting of multiple hulls – equipped with very special capabilities,” Rear Admiral Rastegari said.

AEOI Chief: New Centrifuges Installation Part of Strategic Action Plan

that the moves by Iran to install new centrifuges at the Fordow Nuclear Facility is happening under the Strategic Action Plan of the Iranian Parliament. "This issue has been pursued within the Iranian Parliament's Strategic Action Plan to Lift Sanctions and Protect Iranian Nation's Interests, which was approved in late 2020," Eslami said while referring to installation of new centrifuges in Fordow Facility. Iraq connects electrical grid with Saudi Arabia

Al-Monitor, June 16, 2022

Iraq has started connecting its electricity system to Saudi Arabia's. Iraq's Ministry of Electricity said yesterday that it has begun establishing interconnection stations with Saudi Arabia, the official Iraqi News Agency reported. Electricity interconnectors run under water, underground or via overhead cables and can connect electricity stations between two countries, allowing one to send electricity to another. Iraq has long been plagued by electricity problems and large swaths of the country are without power for much of the day. It is particularly an issue in the summer, when temperatures can near 50 degrees Celsius (120 Fahrenheit). Many Iraqis use gas-powered generators to power cooling systems. Iraq has been working with Saudi Arabia on electricity sharing for some time. In 2020, Iraqi officials discussed importing electricity with their

Saudi counterparts in order to avoid the Trump administration's sanctions on Iran.

Silence from Baghdad as Turkish drone kills Yazidi child in Sinjar

The government of Iraq has yet to comment on a Turkish drone strike that killed a 12-year-old boy in the town of Sinune yesterday, the latest in a string of attacks in the Sinjar region of northern Iraq, adding to fury among Yazidis, a marginalized community that was subjected to genocide by the Islamic State. Nobel laureate Nadia Murad, a Yazidi genocide survivor who was enslaved by IS, called Turkey's attack "an act of terrorism." "Iraq has the ultimate responsibility to stop Turkey from attacking Sinjar," said Murad Ismael, a prominent Yazidi activist. "The international community also has a moral responsibility towards Yazidis and the people of Sinjar. It is both painful and illogical that these attacks go [unaddressed] as if they are legitimate. It seems Turkey can get away with anything," Ismael told Al-Monitor. The Turkish drone targeted a local council associated with the Shingal Resistance Units (YBS), an all-Yazidi militia that was established with the help of an armed Turkish Kurdish group, the Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK), to help defend their people in the wake of IS' genocidal sweep through Sinjar in August 2014.

IS hideouts and operatives in Iraq's western desert stretching to the Syrian border have also been targeted, however, as well as in and close to the capital. On June 15, Iraq's

Counterterrorism Services (CTS) announced they had killed three members of "IS gangs" in Kirkuk in an operation that started at dawn that day. A week before, the CTS had conducted an airdrop into the Anbar desert that resulted in the killing of a local leader there. Kirkuk is an oil-rich region that both Baghdad and Erbil lay claim to but under the central government since late 2017.

"The choice of the name Babel on the new pistol to denote the force," he added, noting that "some foreign experts were hired to supervise the qualitative control of the weapon."

Also, the headquarters of the intelligence service in Baghdad was hit with an explosive device. All this seems to fall within the scope of a systematic campaign of escalation launched by the Shiite militias against the intelligence service, targeting Kadhim.

US carries out strike inside Syria, targeting 'senior' terrorist leader: CENTCOM

Extremist organizations like Hurras al-Din continue to present a threat to America and its allies, CENTCOM said, adding that al-Qaeda-aligned militants use Syria as a safe haven to coordinate with external affiliates and plan operations outside of Syria.

The United Arab Emirates (UAE) has licensed the third unit of its Barakah Nuclear Energy Plant, the UAE's permanent representative to the International Atomic Energy Agency, Hamad Al Kaabi, told reporters on Friday. Construction of the unit in Abu Dhabi's Al Dhafra region was completed last year and it is on track to start up and deliver clean electricity in 2023, according to the UAE's Nuclear Energy Corporation (ENEC). The Barakah nuclear plant is the Arab world's first multi-unit operating nuclear energy plant.

UAE's Barakah nuclear plant to begin fuel loading in unit 3

The UAE's Barakah nuclear power plant will begin fuel loading for its third reactor, the country's atomic regulatory said in a statement on June 19, as the OPEC producer diversifies its electricity mix away from hydrocarbons. The Federal Authority for Nuclear Regulation will deploy inspectors to oversee the fuel loading "to ensure the fuel load and testing processes are completed according to requirements," it said. On June 17, the FANR granted Nawah Energy Co., the operations and maintenance unit of Emirates Nuclear Energy Corp., the license to operate the third of four units at the Barakah nuclear power plant located in the emirate of Abu

Dhabi. FANR expects to start looking at the operating license application for the fourth and final unit in the fourth quarter of 2022.

Houthi: Yemeni army's defense capabilities greater than many Arab states
